

WAWE BOARD PROGRAM

GLOBAL NEW GUIDELINES

After 20 years of WAWE in which the WE has grown and become known throughout the World, we should take a step forward and make our directive structure more all-encompassing by giving voice and responsibility and a greater number of people.

This way we intend to extend the WAWE Board of Directors, which will be composed of seven elements.

We decided to divide the management into seven áreas::

- 1 Institutional Relations, and official disclosure of the WE
- 2 Judges
- 3 Economic Department
- 4 Development of WE for Youth
- 5 International Sporting Events
- 6 Communication
- 7 WAWE American Continent Relationship

We propose to remain focused on the development of Working Equitation throughout the world by trying to get more countries to stick to WAWE and our sport.

Continue the dialogue with FEI to try to get WAWE recognized as the international guardianship of Working Equitation.

There should be greater communication between the international entities responsible for WE in the different countries so that by the end of each year the Calendar of international tests for the following year is published.

National competitions should also be communicated for general knowledge and each country should send WAWE an annual activities report

Create a Working Equitation World ranking of horses and riders, with prizes to be awarded at the end of each year.



JUDGES

Maintain and boost the organization of Formation Courses for New International Judges

Organize Recycling Courses for International Judges

Organize Training Courses for Track Commissioners, adapting to FEI standards

Countries wishing to organize Training Courses for their judges, should give WAWE knowledge of these initiatives, to which the international judges will be invited.

Continue the recent policy of giving an ever greater explanation of how to execute and judge the different exercises of WE tests (Dressage, Maneability, Speed and Cow)

Propose an amendment to the Regulation so that judges can continue to judge until the age of 70 (instead of the current 65)

Sporting Events

The pandemic situation of years 2020 and 2021 have done nothing but prove the engagement of all of our nations in keeping our sport events very much alive.

Creating an International Competition made out of several stages hosted in different locations (countries) around the globe, that may enable a couple of riders per nation to accumulate points and in this way, play for victory under the flag of their nation.

Also create competitions on different continents of such a project would rely on what has been done in the past with events such as the Haras Cup in the USA or the World cup once organized in Brazil

Creation of a division of category of tests (e.g. international tests of *, ** and ***) as it is done in other equestrian disciplines, making the distribution of the competitions categories according to the compliance of parameters established in different areas (Conditions of Proof, Prize Money, floors, quality of obstacles, etc.)

In the international competitions we propose the creation of three reports (that must be completed, by the delegate, president of the jury and representative of the riders) and that can help in defining the level of the Competitions in the future

WAWE-American Continent Relationship

The General objective is to expand and to consolidate Working Equitation in the America's bearing in mind the sanitary barriers and international travel costs



Although in America there are countries with high horse population the strategy have two segments:

Group 1 – Countries with no active WE – implement the discipline with strategic alliances that will help the sport to grow

Group 2 – Countries with active WE – organizing:

- Challenge of America's (like in Dressage) (2-3 judges travelling for the American Countries with the same rules tests and courses.
- International Competitions with borrowed horses
- Develop WE in countries that started already but needs to have a refresh (Mexico and Brasil)

Have a minimum of 1 International Competition in America

Create an American Board Group inside WAWE and with the America's Countries to work together as a team in the growth of the discipline in America.

Development of WE for Youth

WAWE Campus in different countries during summer holidays for Juniors and Young Riders with trainers approved by WAWE.

Development of a WAWE Cup for Juniors/YR along the year with a final at the end of every year.

Creation of a virtual campus with virtual lessons with different judges, riders and trainers to teach Juniors and Young Riders the main aspects of the discipline (creation of video tutorials and videoconferences).

Economic Department

As has already been approved in previous GA's we intend to set in motion the payment of each country an annual fee to WAWE so that we can have a working fund, in order to meet any expenses, which may be necessary for the development of the discipline



Communication

There should be a dynamic communication on the site and Facebook - we also need a new homepage with nice videos, pictures and everything.

The calendar of international competitions must be posted on the website and also the national competitions of each country

The list of judges should have also all their contacts, at least mail addresses at the WAWE homepage. It is important especially for "new" organizers, can get in contact directly with the judges

The list of representatives should be added to homepage too.

WAWE Facebook page should also be filled with international competitions calendars, results and so on for better advertising and promotion

Every 6 months all representatives should be invited for a zoom meeting with the Board, to hear about their work, ideas, wishes and to let them know about new countries, rules or what WAWE is doing, after what, new ideas can be collected
